Recommencement of face-to-face

From 9 April 2022

Domestic visitors and prisoners must have received at least two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine.

Visit bookings will commence on Monday 4 April 2022.

- 1 adult visitor per prisoner
- Due to high case numbers amongst children and challenges with testing, visits remain paused for children under 18 years, however we will seek to resume these again very soon.
- Visitors are required to administer a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) and provide evidence of negative result prior to entry into the visit
- Visitors MUST show proof of valid vaccination (two doses) at the institution upon registration
- Visitors and prisoners must wear surgical masks at all times during the visit
- Strict social distancing of 1.5 metres from your visitor must be adhered to at all times
- Reduced number of tables available for social distancing measured as per density limits at each institution
- Visit times determined by institutional requirements
- No food allowed
- No face-to-face visits allowed for prisoners in 14-day quarantine
- Virtual visits still available by Zoom/iPad.

ALL domestic visitors and prisoners must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
